Update study on cost and return of tossa jute production at farm level in different areas of Bangladesh	The Benefit Cost Ratio (BCR) was found 1.56 on the basis of full cost and 2.33 on the basis of cash cost. The average total variable cost (TVC) per hectare was amounted to Tk. 79541, the average cash cost (TCC) per hectare was about 69% of the TVC, amounting to Tk. 55616 in the case of Tossa Jute production at farm level. The gross return and gross margin was observed in Tk. 1,26,484 and 46,944 ha ⁻¹ respectively. Policy makers as well as farmers will be informed about the present cost and return situation of tossa jute cultivation.
